

New courses offered this year

To start with, Sean Gibbons will be back in Montréal in December to teach a Thoracic course.

For those who have taken the Visceral 1 course, Dee Ahern from Florida will be back to teach the Visceral II course in January 2011.

For the 1st time in Montréal since 1998, Noigroup (Neuro Orthopaedic Institute) from Australia, run by David Butler, world renowned physiotherapist for the treatment of patients with neurogenic pain, will be giving a course on the "Mobilisation of the nervous system".
